Purpose: To establish a spending-neutral reserve fund to keep the Federal Water Pollution Control Act focused on protection of water quality, to establish bright lines for Federal jurisdiction, and to create clear and unambiguous exemptions for features that the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency or the Secretary of the Army, acting through the Chief of Engineers, claim they are not seeking to regulate.

5 The Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of  
6 the Senate may revise the allocations of a committee or  
7 committees, aggregates, and other appropriate levels in  
8 this resolution for one or more bills, joint resolutions,  
9 amendments, amendments between the Houses, motions,  
10 or conference reports relating to ensuring that Federal ju-  
11 risdiction under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act  
12 (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.) is focused on water quality,  
13 which may include limiting jurisdiction based on the move-  
14 ment of birds, mammals, or insects through the air or over  
15 the land, the movement of water through the ground, or  
16 the movement of rainwater or snowmelt over the land, or  
17 limiting jurisdiction over puddles, isolated ponds, roadside  
18 ditches, irrigation ditches, stormwater systems, waste-  
19 water systems, or water delivery, reuse, or reclamation  
20 systems, by the amounts provided in such legislation for  
21 those purposes, provided that such legislation would not  
22 raise new revenue and would not increase the deficit over  
23 either the period of the total of fiscal years 2016 through  
24 2020 or the period of the total of fiscal years 2016  
25 through 2025.
