**A BILL**

To require the advice and consent of the Senate for entry  
or reentry into any international climate agreement, and  
for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “No Climate Treaties  
5       Act of 2026”.

6       **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR SENATE ADVICE AND CONSENT**

7                       **FOR ENTRY OR REENTRY INTO INTER-**  
8                       **NATIONAL CLIMATE AGREEMENTS.**

9       Any agreement providing for the entry or reentry of  
10      the United States into an international climate agreement

1 or an agreement mandating legally binding reductions in  
2 domestic greenhouse gas emissions, including the decision  
3 of the 21st Conference of Parties of the United Nations  
4 Framework Convention on Climate Change, adopted in  
5 Paris December 12, 2015 (commonly known as the “Paris  
6 Agreement”), shall be considered a treaty and submitted  
7 to the Senate for its advice and consent under clause 2  
8 of section 2 of article II of the Constitution of the United  
9 States.

10 **SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR INTER-**  
11 **NATIONAL CLIMATE AGREEMENTS.**

12 No Federal funds may be obligated or expended to  
13 implement, enforce, or otherwise comply with any inter-  
14 national climate agreement or agreement mandating le-  
15 gally binding reductions in domestic greenhouse gas emis-  
16 sions unless the agreement has received the advice and  
17 consent of the Senate under clause 2 of section 2 of article  
18 II of the Constitution of the United States.
